Dahlias, Dahlias, Dahlias!



Owned by Olly Chuchryk, *Charing House Gardens* specializes in dahlias. All of her varieties are grown successfully in Ottawa Valley's heavy clay, without the help of greenhouses. Fresh cut flowers have been sold seasonally to Ottawa area florists and markets since 2005, and now dahlia tubers are available through the internet across Canada.

Over the years, Charing House initiatives have included market stands at the Ottawa Farmers' Market at Lansdowne Park, the outdoor market in the Little Italy area of Ottawa, and at Shouldice Berry Farms. An old fashioned self-serve flower cart at the end of her driveway also provides bouquets at reasonable prices for friends and neighbors.

Two interviews with the CBC can be heard on her web site, and 'Gardenmaking', a Canadian gardening magazine, interviewed Olly for their article 'Dazzling Dahlias' in the Fall 2010 issue.

Ollie will be joining us for the February meeting and will cover everything about growing dahlias, from planting, growing, picking, to the harvesting, storing, and dividing of tubers. Astrid is a passionate speaker who has presented at Canada Blooms and at the Garden and Florist Expo.

Astrid will be presenting a talk on the subject of "Using power perennials in low maintenance design."
