### DESIGN DEFINITIONS

**Table Segment** – Is a functional table setting and must include at least one (1) place setting, suitable linens and a decorative unit.

**Hand-Tied Bouquet** – A design of plant material making use of it’s own stems which are usually tied with string, raffia or ribbon.

**Stretch Design** – A design in two units, one smaller than the other, having a prominent component connecting the two units which is referred to as the “stretch component”. The stretch component must imply a stretching force. The overall appearance should be off two parts of a whole being forcefully pulled apart.
