With budgets tightening and environmental concerns, many folks are considering growing food instead of just pretty flowers, and using native species instead of introduced species. But fear not - just because a plant is edible AND native, it doesn't have to be ugly. In fact, with a little thought you can create a beautiful landscape that mixes native edible plants in that feeds all your senses. Bettina will introduce you to some of her favorite edibles and even recipe ideas to go with them.

Bettina's background is as a horticulturist and landscaper, and also as a Park Ranger, and currently her work involves environmental assessments related to the protection of wetlands, Species at Risk, Significant Natural Areas, and ecological communities. 
